HOW TO SCHEDULE YOUR EXAMINATION

ONLINE APPLICATION:

To register for your examination, please visit www.nws-a.org to complete the online application form. You will receive an authorization email from NWSA within 48 hours. After you receive your authorization email from NWSA, wait 24 hours before calling PSI to schedule examination.

Once you have been approved, you are responsible for scheduling an appointment to take your examination(s).

INTERNET SCHEDULING

For the fastest and most convenient test scheduling process, PSI recommends that Test Takers schedule for their exams using the Internet. Test Takers may schedule online by accessing PSI's scheduling website at https://test-takers.psiexams.com/nwsa. Internet scheduling is available 24 hours-a-day. In order to schedule by Internet, complete the steps below:

- Once eligibilities are received by PSI, Test Takers will be able to go to https://test-takers.psiexams.com/nwsa for online scheduling.
- From the website, Test Takers will be able to select a desired testing date and location.
- After scheduling your examination appointment online you will receive an email confirmation from no-reply@psiexams.com. This will contain the test date, time, site address and directions.

REQUIRED IDENTIFICATION AT THE EXAMINATION SITE

Test Takers need to provide one (1) form of identification.

Test Takers must register for the examination with their LEGAL first and last name as it appears on their government issued identification. The required identification below must match the first and last name under which the Test Taker is registered. Test Takers are required to bring one (1) form of a valid (non-expired) signature bearing identification to the examination site.

REQUIRED IDENTIFICATION - Choose One

- State issued driver's license
- State issued identification card
- US Government Issued Passport
- US Government Issued Military Identification Card
- US Government Issued Alien Registration Card
- → Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC)

CANCELING AN EXAMINATION APPOINTMENT

You may cancel and reschedule an examination appointment without forfeiting your fee if your cancellation notice is received 2 days in advance by 5:00 p.m. Pacific Standard Time.

Note: A voice mail message is not an acceptable form of cancellation. Please use the telephone system and speak to a Customer Service Representative.

MISSED APPOINTMENT OR LATE CANCELLATION

Your registration will be invalid, you will not be able to take the examination(s) as scheduled, and you will forfeit your examination fee, if you:

- Do not cancel your appointment 2 days before the scheduled examination date;
- Do not appear for your examination appointment;
- Arrive after examination start time;
- Do not present proper identification.

SECURITY PROCEDURES

The following security procedures will apply during the examination:

Test Takers will receive scratch paper and a pencil at the test site. No calculators are allowed or provided.

Antenna and Line Specialty (ANT) Test Takers ONLY will be issued the Antenna and Line Supplementary Booklet at the test site for use during the examination.

While at an examination site, you are considered to be a professional and shall be treated as such. In turn, you must conduct yourself in a professional manner at all times. While at the site, you shall not use words or take actions that are vulgar, obscene, libelous, or that would denigrate the staff or other Test Takers.

- NO conversing or any other form of communication among Test Takers is permitted once you enter the <u>examination</u> area.
- Cell phones, pagers, and children are not allowed in the examination site. NO personal items are to enter the examination site. Test Takers are encouraged to leave all personal belongings except their keys in their car.
- No smoking, eating, or drinking will be allowed at the examination site.
- Copying or communicating examination content is a violation of security policy. Either one may result in the disqualification of examination results and may lead to legal action.

SCORE REPORTS

Test Takers will receive a pass/fail score report at the end of testing.
